<p>Student Membership</p>	<p>STUDENT membership is open to any person currently studying part-time or full-time in one of the recognised professions for becoming a registered practitioner:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chartered Psychologist • Doctor of Medicine • Registered Nurse • Occupational Therapist • Physiotherapist • Social Worker • Speech & Language Therapist <p>Students of subjects that are related to the field of brain injury and/or health or social care may also apply and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>Benefits of Membership include - copy of BABICM Competency Framework & Standards documents, discounted rates at BABICM events, access to members only section of BABICM website for news & relevant articles.</p> <p>Please note: Eligibility for student membership ends at the time that the person finishes studying, at which point they have the option to register for one of the other membership categories.</p> <p>Student Membership is £25 per annum</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Occupational Therapist • Physiotherapist • Social Worker • Speech & Language Therapist <p>Any other registered professions will be submitted to the council for consideration.</p> <p>Applicants must be registered with a Professional Body that is responsible for actively monitoring the registrants CPD.</p> <p>Membership in this category will be on a temporary basis for the length of time they require to prepare for their peer review for admission to the Advanced Registered Practitioner Category.</p> <p>Benefits of Membership include - copy of BABICM Competency Framework & Standards documents, discounted rates at BABICM events, access to members only section of BABICM website for news & relevant articles.</p> <p>Practitioner Membership is £100 per annum</p>
Advanced Registered Practitioner	<p>Advanced members will have significant and relevant case management experience over a period that is the equivalent to 3500 hours (three years full time working) as a case manager. All applicants for this category must be existing BABICM Registered Practitioner Members and acceptance into the Advanced membership category will be dependent on peer review assessment. Candidates must submit evidence to their peer reviewers to demonstrate that their practice is commensurate with current BABICM Standards and the Competency Framework at Levels 2 & 3.</p> <p>Benefits of Membership include – copy of newsletter online, a copy of the annual yearbook, copies of BABICM Competency Framework & Standards documents, discounted rate at BABICM events. Access to members only section of BABICM website for news & relevant articles, access to other member details on the website for networking purposes. Member details will be displayed on the BABICM website under list of our advance members.</p> <p>Advanced Practitioner Membership is £100 per annum</p>
