

## Access to Vaccinations for COVID-19

As you will be aware the vaccination programme has now been extended to include;

- The Green book (COVID bible) defines both:
  - Clinically extremely vulnerable – “are considered to be at high risk of severe illness from COVID-19”
  - Frontline healthcare staff

Local CCGs are responsible for the role of vaccines for none NHS individuals/companies.

To access the vaccine for frontline health and social care staff, you will need to identify every CCG where the staff live and then email each CCG to request access to the vaccination. This link will help you to identify the CCGs by postcode:

The vaccination hub at **Watford Football Club** has offered an ad-hoc arrangement for you to access your vaccine if you are able to attend their site and this has been put in place to avoid wastage of the vaccine. If you do wish to attend Watford to access your vaccine:

- You can attend as walk ins to the WHHT vaccination centre at Watford Football Ground ideally before 7pm on 28th Thursday evening. This is because the centre has vaccine that must be used by this date or it will be wasted.
- You should take along your NHS no, photo ID, a letter from your employer confirming you are a healthcare worker or proof of membership of a regulatory/ overseeing body for your profession, to validate your entitlement to a vaccine within the JCVI cohort of health and social care workers.
- The Vaccination Centre is open 7.30 -7pm, 7 days per week but is closed when Watford Football Club is playing at home (eg Tuesday 2nd Feb).

In addition NHS England have stated that local hospitals will be set up to carry out mass vaccinations and the priority is: 1. Care home & staff 2. Front line care/support staff and over 80’s. A consent form for staff will need to be completed and sent to [england.contactus@nhs.net](mailto:england.contactus@nhs.net) The subject line of the email must contain the following words: “COVID 19 Vaccine Form” The carers/support workers will get an automated

response to say their application has been received. They will then receive an email, and a letter, advising where and when they should go to have the vaccination. If they don't receive this email within 48 hrs they need to call 0300 311 2233 to tell them they have sent in the form.
